What remains hidden from the mirror...

Driving a large truck in dense and mixed traffic calls for a lot of prudence from the driver. Busy urban streets can be very strenuous.

While waiting for the traffic lights or slowing down for a nearside turn, pedestrians or cyclists may enter the area just before or beside the vehicle and be overlooked and subsequently be involved in a collision when the truck drives off again.

In order to increase the road safety, several fields of view around the vehicle have been mandated in the European Union, to cover those areas that are hidden from direct view through the windows.

When manoeuvring in heavy traffic the truck driver must constantly scan the various mirrors mounted on his vehicle, to make sure that no other traffic is present in the direct vicinity of the truck.

The DAF front view camera system helps a great deal to make truck driving easier and safer. In one single glance, the driver can oversee a much larger area than legally required, which substantially reduces the chance that more vulnerable traffic participants get overlooked.

The front view camera is legally accepted as an alternative for the front view mirror.
